If the heaven of heavens will not suffice you, how much less even this house which I have built for your name? ²⁸ Yet, O Lord God of Israel, regard my plea, to hear the prayer which your servant prays to you in your presence this day, ²⁹ so that your eyes may be open towards this house about which you said: My name will be there, to listen to the plea which your servant prays at this place by day and night. ³⁰ And you will listen to the plea of your servant, and of your people Israel, which they will pray towards this place. You will hear in your heavenly dwelling-place; you will act and be gracious to them.

Prophecy 2

From the Prophecy of Isaiah (61:10-62:5)

Let my soul rejoice in the Lord, for he has clothed me with the outer robe of salvation and the inner garment of joy. He has put a crown on me like a bridegroom, and adorned me with ornaments like a bride. ¹¹ And like the earth producing her flower, and like a garden its seed, so will the Lord, make justice to spring up, and gladness before all nations. ¹ For Sion's sake I will not be quiet, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest, until my justice goes out like light, and my salvation burns like a torch. ² The nations will see your justice, and kings your glory. And he will call you by a new name, which the Lord will determine. ³ You will be a beautiful crown in the hand of the Lord, and a royal diadem in the hand of your God. ⁴ You will no longer be called Forsaken, and your land will no longer be called Desert, for you will be called My Pleasure, and your land Inhabited, for the Lord has taken pleasure in you, and your land will be inhabited. ⁵ As a young man lives with a virgin, so will your sons live with you. It will come to pass that as a bridegroom rejoices over a bride, so the Lord will rejoice over you.

Prophecy 3

From the Prophecy of Isaiah (60:1-16)

Be enlightened, be enlightened, O Jerusalem, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen over you. ² See, darkness will cover the earth, and gross darkness the nations, but the Lord will appear to you, and his glory will be seen over you. ³ Kings will walk in your light, and nations in your brightness. ⁴ Lift up your eyes round about, and see your children gathered. See, all your sons have come from far, and your daughters will be carried on shoulders. ⁵ Then you will see, fear and be amazed in your heart, for the wealth of the sea will, together with nations and peoples, will come to you. Herds of camels will come to you, ⁶ and the camels of Midian and Ephah will envelop you. All from Sheba will come, bearing gold, and bringing incense and precious stones. They will announce the good news of the Lord's salvation. ⁷ All the flocks of Kedar will be gathered to you, and the rams of Nebaioth will come to you. Acceptable sacrifices will be offered on my altar, and my house of prayer will be glorified. ⁸ Who are these *that* fly like clouds, and like doves with their young? ⁹ The islands have waited for me, and the ships of Tarshish among the first, to bring your children from far, and their silver and their gold with them, for the sake of the holy name of the Lord, and because the Holy One of Israel is glorified. ¹⁰ Strangers will build your walls, and their kings will wait on you, for because of my anger I struck you, but because of mercy I loved you. ¹¹ Your gates will always be opened; they will not be shut by day or night, in order to bring to you the power of the nations, and their kings as captives. ¹² For nations and kings who will not serve you will perish, and *those* nations will be made utterly desolate. ¹³ The glory of Lebanon will come to you, with the cypress, pine and cedar together to glorify my holy place. ¹⁴ The sons of those who humbled and provoked you will come to you in fear. You will be called City of *the* Lord, Sion of the Holy One of Israel. ¹⁵ Because you have become desolate and hated, and there was no helper, I will make you a perpetual joy, a gladness for generations of generations. ¹⁶ You will suck the milk of nations, and eat the wealth of kings. You will know that I am the Lord who saves you and delivers you, the God of Israel.

Tone 3

Today Constantine and his mother Eléni reveal the precious cross, the weapon of Orthodox Christians against their enemies, for it is revealed to us as a great and fearful sign in warfare.

Íkos

O faithful, let us honour Constantine together with his mother, Eléni. They listened to the words of the prophet, “by the cedar, the pine and the cypress,” and have discerned the cross which was made from three parts, from which follows the saving passion. They laid all these matters before the Jews so that they could prepare to show the people the great justification which had been hidden for such a long time. They revealed what they had found, so they are observed by everyone as bearers of victory. They carry an invincible weapon as a great and fearful sign in warfare.

Synaxáron

Today we remember the holy renowned and great sovereigns Constantine and Eléni, who were crowned by God and equals-to-the apostles. They lived in the Fourth Century. In 312 he caused the cross to be painted on the shields of his army and then won the battle at Milvian Bridge. He

entered Rome in triumph and established Christianity as the religion of the Empire. He founded Constantinople as a new Christian city. His mother was instrumental in building churches throughout the Holy Land. On the Twenty First Constantine was united to his holy mother Eléni in a common destiny.

1: It is the day of Resurrection; O people, let us be radiant. It is Pascha, the Pascha of the Lord, for Christ God has made us pass from death to life and from earth to heaven and we sing the triumphal song.

3: Come and drink a new drink, not one miraculously produced from a barren rock, but from the Spring of incorruption which pours out from the tomb of Christ in whom we are made firm

4: Let the Prophet Habakuk who was inspired by God, stand with us in the divine guard. Let him point out the radiant Angel, who announces with resounding voice, “To-day there is salvation for the world, for Christ has risen as the almighty *Lord*.”

7: The one who set free the children from the furnace, becomes man and suffers as a mortal. The one who is the only blessed and most glorious God of our fathers clothes the mortal through suffering with the splendour of incorruption.

This is the chosen and holy day, the first of Sabbaths, the Queen and Lady, the Feast of Feasts, and the Festival of Festivals on which we bless Christ for ever.
