He was not divided into two persons, but known as one in two natures. O honourable and all-blessed Lady, plead with him to have mercy on our souls.

From the Letter of Jude (1:1-25)

Judas, a servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to those who are called "Dear People" in God the Father, and kept for Jesus Christ. ² May mercy, peace and love be increased for you. ³ Dear people, being very eager to write to you about our common salvation, I found it necessary to write and appeal to you to contend for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints. ⁴ For admission has been secretly gained by some who long ago were designated for this condemnation, ungodly persons who pervert the grace of our God into depravity and deny our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ. ⁵ Now I desire to remind you, although you were once for all fully informed, that the One who saved a people from the land of Egypt, afterwards destroyed those who did not believe. ⁶ And the angels who did not keep their own position, but left their proper dwelling, have been kept by him in eternal chains in the lowest gloom until the judgment of the great day. ⁷ In the same way Sodom and Gomórrah and the surrounding cities, who acted immorally and indulged in unnatural lust, serve as an example by undergoing a punishment of eternal fire. ⁸ Yet in a similar manner these men in their dreaming defile the flesh, reject authority and revile the glorious ones. ⁹ But when the archangel Michael, contending with the devil, disputed about the body of Moses, he did not presume to pronounce a reviling judgment on him, but said, "The Lord rebuke you." ¹⁰ But these men revile whatever they do not understand, and by those things that they know by instinct as irrational animals do, they are destroyed. 11 Woe to them! For they walk in the way of Cain, and abandon themselves for the sake of gain to Balaam's error, and perish in Korah's rebellion. 12 These are blemishes on your love feasts, as they boldly carouse together, looking after themselves; waterless clouds, carried along by winds; fruitless trees in late autumn, twice dead, uprooted; ¹³ wild waves of the sea, casting up the foam of their own shame; wandering stars for whom the nether gloom of darkness has been reserved for ever. 14 It was of these also that Enoch in the seventh generation from Adam prophesied, saying, "Behold, the Lord came with his holy myriads," to execute judgment on all, and to convict all the ungodly of all their deeds of ungodliness which they have committed in such an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against him." ¹⁶ These are grumblers, malcontents, following their own passions, loudmouthed boasters, flattering people to gain advantage. ¹⁷ But you must remember, dear people, the predictions of the apostles of our Lord Jesus

Christ. ¹⁸ They said to you, "In the last time there will be scoffers who follow their own ungodly passions." ¹⁹ It is these who set up divisions; *they* are worldly people *and* devoid of the Spirit. ²⁰ But you, dear people, build yourselves up on your most holy faith. Pray in the Holy Spirit; ²¹ keep yourselves in the love of God. Wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ that leads to eternal life. ²² And convince some who doubt; ²³ save some, by snatching them out of the fire. Have mercy on others with fear *and* hate even the garment spotted by the flesh. ²⁴ Now to him who is able to keep you from falling and to present you without blemish before the presence of his glory with rejoicing, ²⁵ to the only God, our Saviour through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion, and authority, before all time, now and for ever. Amen.
