Synaxáron

Today we remember the holy apostle and evangelist Luke. He was a physician who travelled with Paul on some of the missionary journeys. He wrote the two-volume Gospel and the Acts of the Apostles. There is a story that he also wrote the first icons and so is regarded as the father of iconography. On the Eighteenth the frail course of his life came to an end.

Brothers, conduct yourselves wisely toward outsiders, making the most of the time. ⁶ Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer every one. ⁷ Tychicós will tell you all about my affairs; he is a beloved brother and faithful minister and fellow servant in the Lord. ⁸ I have sent him to you for this very purpose, that you may know how we are and that he may encourage your hearts, ⁹ and with him Onísimos, the faithful and beloved brother, who is one of yourselves. They will tell you of everything that has taken place here. ¹⁰ Arístarchos my fellow prisoner greets you, and Mark the cousin of Barnabas (concerning whom you have received instructions -- if he comes to you, receive him), ¹¹ and Jesus who is called Justus. These are the only men of the circumcision among my fellow workers for the kingdom of God, and they have been a comfort to me. ¹⁴ Luke the beloved physician and Dimás greet you. ¹⁵ Give my greetings to the brethren at Laodikía, and to Nymphá and the church in her house. ¹⁶ And when this letter has been read among you, have it read also in the church of the Laodikéans; and see that you read also the letter from Laodice'a. ¹⁷ And say to Árchippos, "See that you fulfil the ministry which you have received in the Lord." ¹⁸ I, Paul, write this greeting with my own hand. Remember my fetters. Grace be with you.

Gospel

From the Holy Gospel according to Luke (10:16-21)

The Lord said to his disciples, "The one who hears you hears me, and the one who rejects you rejects me, and the one who rejects me rejects the one who sent me." ¹⁷ The seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in your name!" ¹⁸ And he said to them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. ¹⁹ Behold, I have given you authority to tread upon serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy; and nothing shall hurt you. ²⁰ Nevertheless do not rejoice in

this, that the spirits are subject to you; but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.”²¹ In that same hour he rejoiced in the Holy Spirit and said, "I thank thee, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that you have hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to babes; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will.”
