The infertile Anna leapt for joy when she conceived Mary the Virgin, who in turn will conceive God the Word in the flesh. In the fullness of her joy, she cried out. "Rejoice with me, all you tribes of Israel, for I have conceived according to the will of God my Saviour. He has answered my prayer and ended my shame in fulfilment of his promise. He will heal the pains of my heart through the pains of child-bearing."

S5: O Lord, I have waited for you for your name's sake;  
my soul has waited for your word,  
my soul has hoped in the Lord.

The *Lord* who made waters gush from the rock permitted your womb to carry the ever-virgin Mary through whom our salvation will come. By this, you were saved from shame. No longer will you live on earth as infertile, for you will bear the Earth which produces the Tree of Life. In accordance with his will he has rescued the human race from every shame by taking on our human form and becoming man, for he is rich in mercy.

S4: Let Israel hope in the Lord  
from morning watch until night,  
from morning watch.

See, the promises of the prophets are fulfilled. The holy mountain is planted in the womb. The divine ladder is set up, the great throne of the King is ready. The place for the Lord's passage is prepared. The dry bush which the fire could not consume is blooming. The treasury of grace is an abundant flow of blessing which heals the infertility of Anna; we glorify her with faith.

### Íkos

The infertile Anna spoke with tears, "You once granted Sarah a son, the Patriarch Isaac, despite her advanced age, because of your promise and protection. You opened the infertile womb of Anna, the mother of Samuel. Observe me at this time and accept my prayers. Fulfil my request." The Benefactor heard her. Because of it, she joyfully conceived the Virgin who will give birth to the Word of God in a way which is beyond description.

### Synaxáriorion

Today we celebrate the conceiving by Anna of the All-holy Theotokos. On the Ninth she became the grandmother of God, for she conceived the mother of her King.

On the same day we also commemorate the rededication of the Church of Resurrection in Jerusalem after the Seventh Century Persian invasion. The principal feast is on 13 September.

We also remember:

Prophetess Anna, mother of Samuel C10 BC  
Abbess Ethelgiva of Shaftesbury C9  
Stephen the "New Light" of Constantinople C19  
O God, have mercy on us through their holy prayers. Amen.

### Katavasías
