Lord I have cried

- O Saviour, you abolished the penalty of the tree of disobedience by being nailed willingly to the tree of the cross. O almighty *Lord*, you broke the bonds of death as God by descending to Hades. Therefore we adore your resurrection from the dead and sing in joy, "Glory to you, O almighty Lord!"
- S8: O Lord, I have cried to you from the depths;
 - O Lord listen to my voice.
- O Lord, you smashed the gates of Hades and demolished the kingdom of death by your death. You rescued the human race from corruption and granted the world life, incorruption and great mercy.
- S7: Let your ears note the voice of my plea.

O people, come and sing about the Saviour's resurrection on the third day. We have all been freed by it from the unbreakable bonds of Hades; we have received life and incorruption. Therefore we cry in unison, "You were crucified, buried and rose again. Unique Lover of the human race, save us by your resurrection."

S6: O Lord, if you mark offences, who will stand? But there is forgiveness with you.

We glorify the Author of our salvation. The world was saved from deceit by his resurrection from the dead. The choir of angels rejoices as the error of demons takes flight. Fallen Adam rises as the Devil is overthrown.

S5: O Lord, I have waited for you for your name's sake; my soul has waited for your word, my soul has hoped in the Lord.

The guards were instructed by the lawless people, "Hide the resurrection of Christ; take money and say, 'The body was stolen from the tomb while we were asleep.' But who has heard of a body being stolen, a body anointed and naked, with its grave clothes left behind in the tomb? O Jews, do not be deceived, study the words of the prophets and understand that he is truly the Redeemer of the world and all-powerful.

S4: Let Israel hope in the Lord from morning watch until night, from morning watch.

Eothinón Gospel 5

From the Holy Gospel according to Luke (24:12-35)

At that time Peter got up and ran to the tomb; stooping and looking in, he saw the linen cloths by themselves; then he went home, amazed at what had happened. 13 That very day two of them were going to a village named Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem, ¹⁴ and talking with each other about all these things that had happened. ¹⁵ While they were talking and discussing together, Jesus himself drew near and went with them. ¹⁶ But their eyes were kept from recognizing him. ¹⁷ And he said to them, "What is this conversation which you are holding with each other as you walk?" And they stood still, looking sad. 18 Then one of them, named Cleopas, answered him, "Are you the only visitor to Jerusalem who does not know the things that have happened there in these days?" ¹⁹ And he said to them, "What things?" And they said to him, "Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, who was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people, ²⁰ and how our chief priests and rulers delivered him up to be condemned to death, and crucified him. ²¹ But we had hoped that he was the one to redeem Israel. Yes, and besides all this, it is now the third day since this happened. ²² Moreover, some women of our company amazed us. They were at the tomb early in the morning ²³ and did not find his body; and they came back saying that they had even seen a vision of angels, who said that he was alive. ²⁴ Some of those who were with us went to the tomb, and found it just as the women had said; but him they did not see." ²⁵ And he said to them, "O foolish men, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! ²⁶ Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?" ²⁷ And beginning with Moses and all the prophets, he interpreted to them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself. ²⁸ So they drew near to the village to which they were going. He appeared to be going further, ²⁹ but they constrained him, saying, "Stay with us, for it is toward evening and the day is now far spent." So he went in to stay with them. 30 When he was at table with them, he took the bread and blessed, and broke it, and gave it to them. ³¹ And their eyes were opened and they recognized him; and he vanished out of their sight. ³² They said to each other, "Did not our hearts burn within us while he talked to us on the road, while he opened to us the scriptures?" ³³ And they rose that same hour and returned to Jerusalem; and they found the eleven gathered together and those who were with them, ³⁴ who said, "The Lord has risen indeed, and has appeared to Simon!" ³⁵ Then they told what had happened on the road, and how he was known to them in the breaking of the bread.

O Saviour, you suffered death in the flesh in order to accomplish our immortality. You lodged in the tomb so that you might rescue us from Hades and raise us with you. For as man you suffered, but as God you have risen. Therefore we cry out, "O Lord, Giver of life, only Lover of the human race, glory to you!"

S3: Praise him with tuneful cymbals; praise him with joyful cymbals.

Let everything with breath praise the Lord.

O Saviour, the rocks were split when your cross was set up on Golgotha.

Although you are silent about the Lord's resurrection, the stones will cry out, especially the stone which was rolled from the grave. Great is your mercy and great the mystery of your dispensation! O Saviour, glory to you!"

Glory: Tone 5

O Christ, how wise are your judgments! You allowed Peter to understand your resurrection through the linen clothes alone, but you talked with Luke and Cleopas while you walked with them. You did not reveal yourself and were taunted as being the only stranger in Jerusalem who did not know what had happened there. Since you order all things in accordance with your creation, you explained to them what the prophets had taught about you. They recognised you in the breaking of the bread when their hearts were burning for your knowledge. When they found the disciples, they openly proclaimed the resurrection. Through it we plead with you to have mercy on us.

Both now: Tone 2

O Virgin Theotokos, you are most blessed, for through the One who was born of you, Hades has been captured and Adam recalled. The curse has been annulled, and Eve set free. Death has been slain, so we are given life. Blessed is Christ our God, whose good will it was. Glory to you!
