Most glorious wonder! Today joy shines in heaven and earth at the commemoration of the martyr Dimítrios. He is crowned with praises by the angels and receives hymns from men. How greatly he suffered! How well he fought the fight! In this way the evil enemy was felled when Christ conquered him.

S5: O Lord, I have waited for you for your name's sake;

my soul has waited for your word,

my soul has hoped in the Lord.

Most glorious wonder! Dimítrios continually enlightens the ends of the earth with rays of miracles brighter than the sun, for he is illuminated by the unfading Light and delights in the Sun which never sets. The clouds of the enemy have been dispelled by his rays, infirmities driven away and the demons vanquished.

S4: Let Israel hope in the Lord

from morning watch until night,

from morning watch.

Most glorious wonder! The three-times blessed Dimítrios, who was pierced for the sake of Christ, continually reveals himself to the foe as a two-edged sword which cuts down the uprisings of the enemy and casts down the boldness of demons. Let us cry out to him, "O holy Dimítrios, save us who continually and faithfully honour you with love."

S3: For there is mercy with the Lord
and abundant redemption with *him*.

He will redeem Israel from all his offences.

You have become tower of true worship. You are securely founded on the rock of faith *and* are not separated by temptations or shaken by afflictions. When the waves of atheism dashed against you in a great torrent and tempest, they did not break down your resolute steadfastness, for you wished to be adorned with the crown of martyrdom.

S2: Every nation, praise the Lord;
every people, acclaim him!

O fight-bearing Dimítrios, you copied in your passion the life-giving passion of Christ and received from him the gift of wonder-working. Therefore, O glorious *martyr*, you save those who hurry to you and free them from many tribulations, for you are well-favoured by Christ. All through the day you stand before him full of glory.

S1: For his mercy is strengthened over us
and the truth of the Lord remains for ever.

O Dimítrios, you came before the life-giving Christ by the shedding of your blood. He shed his own precious blood for your sake and made you a partaker in his glory and his kingdom, for you prevail over the Evil One and make void all his evil tricks.

Glory: Tone 6

Today the universal feast of the passion-bearer has brought us together. O lovers of the feasts of the Church, come, let us celebrate his memorial brilliantly and say, "Hail, for you tore the godless garment with faith and robed yourself with a spirit of courage! Hail, for you destroyed the schemes of the enemy with the power given you by God! Hail, for you spiritually portrayed the sufferings of Christ for us with your pierced limbs! O Dimítrios, adornment of athletes, plead with him to save us from visible and invisible enemies and to rescue our souls.

Both now:

All-holy Lady, the help of the world and hope of Christians, O good one, O Theotokos, we now beg and implore you to plead for us despairing sinners with your Son, our Lord, for you are able to do this by using your motherly privilege with him. O undefiled *Lady*, recognise us, mediate and save your people from the threat which hangs over us. Do not turn away those who praise you for the sake of your merciful compassion.

Of the Day

Prophecy 1

An earthquake will seize the mountains; do not be very angry with us.

From the Prophecy of Isaiah (63:15 - 64:5, 8-9)

Turn from heaven; observe from your holy habitation and from your glory. Where is your zeal and your strength? Where is the abundance of your mercy and of your compassion, that you have held back from us? ¹⁶ For you are our Father. For although Abraham did not know us, and Israel did not acknowledge us, yet do you, O Lord, our Father, deliver us. Your name has been on us from the beginning. ¹⁷ O Lord, why have you made us stray from your way? Why have you hardened our hearts, so that we should not fear you? Return for your servants' sake, for the sake of the tribes of your

inheritance,¹⁸ so that we may inherit a small part of your holy mountain. Our adversaries have trampled your sanctuary.¹⁹ We have become, as at the beginning, when you did not rule over us, and when your name was not called on us.¹ If you open the heaven, trembling from you will seize the mountains. They will melt,² as wax melts before the fire. Fire will burn up the enemies and the name of the Lord will be manifest among the adversaries. At your presence nations will be troubled.³ Whenever you work gloriously, trembling from you will seize the mountains.⁴ From of old we have not heard, neither have our eyes seen a God apart from you, and your works which you will perform for those who wait for mercy.⁵ For these blessings will happen to those who work justice, and they will remember your ways. See, you were angry and we have sinned; therefore we have strayed.⁸ And now, O Lord, you are our Father, and we are clay, all of us the work of your hands.⁹ Do not be very angry with us, and do not always remember our sins, but now look on us, for we are all your people.

Prophecy 2

My people have changed their glory; the heaven is amazed at this.

From the Prophecy of Jeremiah (2:2-12)

Thus says the Lord: I remember the kindness of your youth, and the love of your maturity³ in following the Holy One of Israel, says the Lord, the Holy One of Israel. To the Lord are his first-fruits. All that devoured him will offend; evil will come on them, says the Lord.⁴ Hear the word of the Lord, O house of Jacob, and every family of the house of Israel.⁵ Thus says the Lord: What offence have your fathers found in me, that they have departed far from me, gone after delusions and become vain?⁶ And they did not say: Where is the Lord, who brought us from the land of Egypt, who guided us in the wilderness, in an inaccessible and trackless land, in a land waterless, fruitless and in the shadow of death, in which no man passed through, and no man lived?⁷ I brought you to Carmel, so that you would eat its fruits and its good things. You went in, defiled my land and made my heritage an abomination.⁸ The priests did not say: Where is the Lord? Those who professed the law did not know me. The shepherds also sinned against me, the prophets prophesied by Baal and went after what does not profit.⁹ Therefore I will still plead with you, says the Lord, and will plead with your children's children.¹⁰ Go to the islands of the Cypriots and see. Send to Kedar, observe accurately and see if such things

have been done; ¹¹ if the nations change their gods, although they are not gods. But my people have changed their glory, for that from which they cannot be profited. ¹² The heaven is amazed at this and is very exceedingly horror-struck, says the Lord.

Prophecy 3

God has tested Demetrios and found him worthy.

From the Wisdom of Solomon (3:1-9)

The souls of the just are in the hand of God and no torment will touch them. ² In the sight of the foolish they seemed to die and their departure is taken for misery, ³ and their going from us to be utter destruction, but they are in peace. ⁴ For although they may be punished in the sight of men, yet their hope is full of immortality. ⁵ Having been a little disciplined, they will be greatly rewarded, for God tested them and found them worthy for himself. ⁶ Like gold in the furnace he has tried them and received them as a burnt offering. ⁷ In the time of their visitation they will shine, and run to and fro like sparks among the stubble. ⁸ They will judge the nations, have dominion over the people, and their Lord will reign for ever. ⁹ Those who put their trust in him will understand the truth. Those who are faithful in love will live with him, for grace and mercy *belongs* to his saints and he visits his chosen.

attending the games in that city. The Emperor was enraged when Lyaïos, his favourite gladiator, was killed by Nestor and immediately ordered the execution of Dimítrios. On the Twenty Sixth he confessed the Son of the almighty Father, was pierced and died.

On the same day we remember the great and dreadful earthquake which happened at Constantinople in the Eighth Century. O Word, you caused the earth to move in order to save it, for you filled it with your anger because of your compassion.

We wander in caves and mountains. Therefore, all-praised *martyr*, have compassion and grant us rest. Calm the tempest, put down the anger which rises against us and implore God to grant the world great mercy.

Therefore continually plead that we who honour you may be rescued from sufferings and severe hardships. Fervently pray to him who grants the world great mercy.

Let us honour Dimítrios, who by spears inherited the grace of the Saviour's side which was pierced by a spear and poured out waters of life and incorruption. The one who was most wise in teaching was crowned in the midst of torments. He completed the course of suffering with the shedding of his blood and has shone on the world with miracles. He loved the Master and with mercy loved the poor. He is the intercessor for the Thessalonians in the midst of many and great misfortunes. As we honour

his yearly memorial let us glorify Christ our God who for his sake accomplishes healing for all.
